ESSENTIAL INFORMATION UZBEKISTAN

PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

Your passport needs to be valid for at least six (6) months after your journey ends, and should have a minimum of one (1) blank visa page for entry and exit stamps.

A tourist visa is required for U.S. and passport holders for entry into Uzbekistan and must be obtained prior to departure. There are currently two options available as outlined below. A&K recommends an electronic visa.

Electronic Visa (eVisa): To apply for an eVisa visit https://e-visa.gov.uz/main. The current fee for a single-entry visa is USD \$20 (subject to change without notice.) Read and follow all instructions carefully to ensure a smooth arrival in Uzbekistan.

Visa Stamp: A visa stamp in your passport can be obtained either by applying directly to an Uzbek consulate or through a visa processing service. While there are additional costs involved in using a visa service, this option is available for guests who prefer assistance in the visa process.

Holders of Canadian passports are not required to obtain a tourist visa for entry into Uzbekistan for stays of up to 30 days.

COVID-19 COUNTRY ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & TRAVEL ADVISORIES

Uzbekistan currently has no COVID-19 vaccination or testing requirements for entry for U.S. and Canadian residents. Visit the U.S. Department of State at travel.state.gov or the Government of Canada at travel.gc.ca/travelling/advisories for up-to-date information.

CASH & CREDIT CARDS

Uzbekistan has a primarily cash-based economy. Uzbek law requires that cash transactions must be carried out using local currency (the Uzbek so'm), with the exception of certain hotel charges and visa fees. Major credit cards are not widely accepted, except at large hotels, shops and restaurants catering to international visitors and costly service charges may apply. ATM access is extremely limited throughout the country.

Uzbekistan is a developing nation that has experienced significant reforms in their economic and political institutions over the last several decades; however, the country is still in the process of developing its tourist infrastructure.
