



Arrive Lisbon, Portugal

Later this afternoon, lift off for a bird's-eye perspective as you embark on a private flightseeing excursion by helicopter, gliding through the sky while gazing upon the stunning coastline. August 7, 2022

Bilbao, Spain | *Modern Masterworks*

San Sebastián is renowned for its *pintxos* (as tapas is known in the Basque region), and tonight's dinner is a *pintxos* crawl through the Parte Vieja (Old Town) district, where you sample delicacies from several of the city's finest venues, as well as hear a musical performance by local students in traditional attire. *Hotel Maria Cristina* | *Meals: B D*

August 9, 2022

Monaco | *The World's Playground*

Return to Bilbao for your private flight to Nice. From there, drive to the Principality of Monaco. Located along the French

Riviera, Monaco is an international byword for luxury and fine living. Have lunch at a restaurant with stunning views of the Royal Palace and the yacht-crowded harbor, and then visit the residence of the royal family in the Palais Princier. Within the palace are a series of beautiful tapestries, gilded furniture and paintings. Prince Ranier III also collected over 100 vintage vehicles. You may choose to review the prince's impressive collection of classic cars or transfer directly to your hotel. This evening, enjoy a fabulous private dinner at your hotel. *Hotel Metropole Monte-Carlo* | *Meals: B L D*

August 10, 2022

Monaco | *Beauty Along the Coast*

Depart your hotel in a chauffeur-driven classic car and travel on a cliffside road through verdant vegetation and breathtaking views to arrive at St-Paul-de-Vence, a picturesque village perched on a hilltop overlooking the Mediterranean Sea. Stop for a game of *boules* (similar to bocce) with the locals, and then have lunch at a charming country restaurant. There is time to explore on your own or visit a well-known modern art gallery, Fondation Maeght, which contains one of the largest 20th-century art collections in Europe. Return to Monte Carlo and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. You may wish to visit its famous casino. *Hotel Metropole Monte-Carlo* | *Meals: B L*

August 11, 2022

Budapest, Hungary | *City on the Danube*

Transfer to the airport for your private flight to Budapest, Hungary's scenic capital straddling the Danube River. The city was originally two separate cities, Buda and Pest, which merged in 1873. Budapest's broad avenues and turn-of-the-century architecture have earned it the name "Paris of Eastern Europe." Your visit begins on the west bank in Buda. Have lunch at a restaurant in the Fisherman's Bastion, built on the site of an old rampart that was defended by the fisherman's guild during the Middle Ages. The terrace is a fanciful lookout in neo-Gothic and neo-Romanesque styles, offering spectacular views of the city and surrounding area. Visit Matthias Church, the 13th-century coronation cathedral of Hungarian kings. Then descend underground for a private tour of the Hospital in the Rock, a combination emergency hospital and air-raid shelter, hidden within six miles of natural caves and tunnels beneath Buda Castle Hill. Later this afternoon, arrive at your hotel for check-in. Enjoy dinner at your hotel this evening.

August 12, 2022

Budapest | *Two Cities in One*

Today, explore Pest. Start with a private visit to the palatial

State Opera House, a beautiful neo-Renaissance building commissioned by Emperor Franz Joseph. Opened in 1884, it was painstakingly restored after damages received during World War II. Pause for coffee and tortes at the New York Café, a gem of Belle Époque architecture that retains the elegance and grace of a bygone era. Continue to the Central Market Hall to take in the vast array of foods and crafts for sale throughout its three floors. After lunch, visit the Great Synagogue — the largest in Europe — as well as the Jewish Museum, built in the same style as the synagogue. The museum offers a rich collection of artwork and ritual objects, all of which were hidden in the basement of the National Museum during World War II. Indulge in fine cuisine and wonderful scenery during a candlelit dinner cruise. The capital takes on a new appearance at night as its most impressive riverside attractions, such as the Parliament building, are wonderfully illuminated.

August 13, 2022

Dubrovnik, Croatia | *Medieval Old Town*

Your journey continues with a morning flight to Croatia. Arrive in Dubrovnik, a UNESCO World Heritage Site nicknamed "the Pearl of the Adriatic." Drive to the picturesque town of Konavle and enjoy lunch in a riverside restaurant

located in an old mill. Afterward, pay a private visit to the studio of a local artist, who explains the importance of silk production in this region. Check into your hotel in the late afternoon, and enjoy dinner tonight at one of the city's finest restaurants. *Hotel Excelsior Dubrovnik | Meals: B L D*

August 14, 2022

Dubrovnik | “Pearl of the Adriatic”

Spend the morning exploring the Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site surrounded by impressive medieval stone walls and towers. Stroll along the centuries-old main city promenade known as the Stradun. Lunch today includes a talk by a former Corporal of the Croatian Army Command with firsthand stories of the dissolution of Yugoslavia in 1993. This afternoon, explore this unique and stunningly beautiful city on your own. *Hotel Excelsior Dubrovnik | Meals: B L*

August 15, 2022

Capri, Italy | Roman Resort

Fly to Italy this morning, arriving at Naples Airport. A short drive brings you to Pompeii. Buried in volcanic ash and essentially frozen in time when Mount Vesuvius erupted in 79 AD, the excavated city provides a fascinating glimpse into life during the Roman Empire. After lunch, continue to Sorrento, a popular resort town, where you board a boat for the isle of Capri, a Mediterranean island paradise. Arrive at your hotel, where you dine this evening.

August 16, 2022

Capri | Sparkling Natural Wonder

Visit the beautiful, iridescent Blue Grotto by private boat (conditions permitting), a famous attraction even in the days of the Roman Empire. Enjoy a lunch of fresh seafood near the famous Piazzetta, Capri's most famous square. Always a center of life on the island, the square served as a market until the mid-twentieth century, when it became a fashionable meeting place for locals and visitors alike. Later, choose from a selection of excellent handpicked restaurants and dine on Neapolitan fare this evening. *Hotel Caesar Augustus | Meals: B L D*

August 17, 2022

Capri | Island Experiences

Choose from several sightseeing options, including a shopping expedition in Capri town, boasting a high concentration of



designer shops as well as artisan shops and showrooms. Or perhaps you prefer a visit to a sumptuous historic villa or a chairlift ride to the top of Mount Solaro for a panoramic view across the whole island, the Bay of Naples and the distant mountains of Calabria. You may even prefer to have a private visit to a sandals atelier that was a favorite of Jackie Onassis. Enjoy an afternoon at leisure to people-watch in Capri town, or to relax at your hotel. Gather for cocktails before your farewell dinner in an idyllic setting at Michelin-starred Ristorante Mammà. *Hotel Caesar Augustus | Meals: B D*

August 18, 2022

Depart Naples

Today, your journey ends as you are transferred to Naples by private boat (approximately 75 minutes) to board your homebound flights. *Meals: B*


Sahara Desert | Camel Ride To Your Desert Camp


