China & Mongolia

Delve into China's cultural treasures and the wilds of Mongolia with privileged access to Beijing's Forbidden City, the Terra Cotta Warriors of Xian and Ulaanbaatar's time-honored Naadam Festival.





From city to city and region to region, every destination holds a unique appeal. Go where your dreams lead you, with help from these expert recommendations.



Beijing

Serving as the nation’s capital for seven centuries, Beijing’s traditionally casual pace has yielded to an embrace of modernity and expansion. Historic sites such as the Forbidden City, the Temple of Heaven, Tiananmen Square and the Great Wall are juxtaposed with an ever-growing number of high-rise hotels, gourmet restaurants, shops and art galleries. This city on the move beckons visitors to experience its enduring air of tradition as it hangs on in an era of rapid development.

Yunnan Province: Lijiang & Zhongdian

Nestled among southern China’s rivers, lakes and snow-capped Himalayan peaks, the melting pot of Yunnan Province is home to more than half of the country’s minority groups. Here, the Khampa, Han, Naxi, Lisu, Yi and Pumi peoples mingle against a backdrop of Tibetan monasteries and the pebbled paths of Lijiang’s Old Town. Evocative of James Hilton’s novel, *Lost Horizon*, the mythical romance of this Shangri-La remains as potent as ever.

Xian

World renowned for its army of Terra Cotta Warriors, Xian boasts some of the 20th century’s most stunning archaeological discoveries. These life-size figures, more than 8,000 in all, captivated the world when they were accidentally unearthed in 1974, drawing visitors ever since. Xian was famed throughout the ancient world for its imperial palaces, temples and silk markets. Today, Xian supports a modern industrial center while preserving this rich cultural heritage.



Hong Kong

Hong Kong fronts the vast waterfront of Victoria Harbour, its dazzling skyline and electric atmosphere anchoring its iconic status as the original “East meets West” destination. Beneath its refined veneer of fashion, culture and cuisine beats the pulse of a trade and commerce powerhouse. A former British colony, today’s Hong Kong retains western influences in its educational system, relative political autonomy and freewheeling economy.



Shanghai

One of the world’s largest cities, Shanghai epitomizes modern China’s skillful balance of innovation and heritage. Fashion, finance, technology and transport propel the city forward at breakneck speed, while its historic waterfront bears witness to a colonial past. Towering forests of skyscrapers herald the city’s boundless growth as its port bustles to the incessant din of the global economy. This commercial dynamo shows its cultured side with fine dining venues, contemporary art galleries and chic shopping districts.

Guilin

Facing the banks of the Li River, Guilin’s limestone peaks, lush forests and sparkling clear waters have inspired generations of poets and painters. There are hills to climb, caves to explore, country roads to bike and placid lakes to cruise — offering a tranquil alternative to some of China’s more frenetic cities. Highlights include Elephant Trunk Hill and Reed Flute Cave.





Lhasa

Towering 12,000 feet above sea level, Lhasa is the birthplace of Tibetan Buddhism. The remote, eastern reaches of Lhasa remain a stronghold of Tibetan culture to this day, with the modernity brought by the Han Chinese becoming more evident in the western part of the city.



Chengdu

The capital of Sichuan Province, Chengdu is renowned for its panda research center and the magical face-change performances of its Sichuan Opera. Once a city of cotton-rose hibiscus, satins and brocades, today's Chengdu is a hub of tea houses, culture and commerce.



Gobi Desert

Spanning a vast swath of southern Mongolia, the Gobi Desert's remote dune-scape affords a glimpse into a world that time forgot — a place where herdsmen tend their livestock from *gers* (traditional yurts), dinosaur fossils pepper the cliffsides and travellers can still escape the grid.



Ulaanbaatar

Home to Mongolia's capital and half its population, Ulaanbaatar witnesses a daily collision of past and present. Nomads from the surrounding steppes mingle among businessmen and monks as an emerging economy flourishes in the bustling city streets.

Landscapes of Guilin

With names like Elephant Trunk Hill and Reed Flute Cave, the landscapes of Guilin are as inspiring as they are varied. Go beyond the postcard beauty of these landmarks, learning the cultural connections that bring these breathtaking sites to life.



The Great Wall

Winding thousands of miles, the Great Wall took several dynasties to construct. Few of the world's wonders evoke such awe — or draw as many tourists. Escape to the well-preserved, less-frequented Mutianyu section of the wall, experiencing all of its grandeur with fewer crowds.



Pandas of Chengdu

The Chengdu Panda Breeding and Research Center affords a rare glimpse of China's furry ambassadors to the world. Gain access to the facility and privileged insights from its staff, learning firsthand about the plight and preservation of this iconic endangered species.

Potala Palace

Towering over 330 feet, Lhasa's Potala Palace was once the winter residence of the Dalai Lamas. The imposing complex of defensive fortifications, gardens, tombs and residential quarters looms dramatically over the surrounding city. Explore the winding staircases, courtyards and *stupas* where generations of Dalai Lamas have been laid to rest, gaining insight while monks pay their respects to this hallowed ground.




Terra Cotta Warriors of Xian

Standing 8,000 strong, the Terra Cotta Warriors of Xian bore silent watch over Emperor Qin Shi Huang's burial grounds for more than 2,000 years. This life-size statuary army of men and horses was accidentally unearthed in 1974, setting off an archaeological sensation to rival the discovery of King Tutankhamun's tomb. Gain insider access to the dig site, touring the latest artifacts as they are revealed during the ongoing excavation.

Macau

Experience Macau's charming colonial atmosphere and glamorous casinos as east meets west in this former Portuguese outpost, just a ferry ride away from Hong Kong. Explore Macau's history at the ruins of St. Paul's Church before tempting Lady Luck in one of the city's famed casinos.

Rafting the Li River

Walking Songzangling Monastery

Immerse yourself in the Tibetan culture of Zhongdian at the 300-year-old Songzangling Monastery, home to the Living Buddha. Surrounded by the floral wonders of the Napa forest, this area conjures daydreams of the mythical Shangri-La.

Naadam Festival

Rarely glimpsed by Western eyes, this spectacular triathlon of archery, horse racing and traditional wrestling has tested countless generations of Mongolian tribesmen. Get a front row seat to witness the majesty of this enduring tradition firsthand.
