



## Peru & Bolivia

Travel well off of the beaten path as you walk in the footsteps of Inca emperors and reveal remote Amazonian wonders untouched by the hands of time.

## Lima

Set on a towering bluff overlooking the Pacific, Lima affords a living, breathing study in diversity. The city's architecture, history and culture span Incan, colonial and contemporary international influences. A mild coastal climate complements Lima's endless variety of attractions — inviting visitors to retrace the steps of the conquistadors, savor a plate of ocean-fresh ceviche, and sip an expertly mixed pisco sour.

## The Amazon Basin

Encompassing the world's largest river and rainforest, the Amazon basin spans nearly 40 percent of the South American continent. Those who cruise its namesake river embark on a legendary journey into a vast and unspoiled ecosystem teeming with dolphins, piranha, toucans and monkeys. The basin is also home to several indigenous tribes, some remaining largely isolated from the outside world.

## Cusco & the Sacred Valley

The former Incan capital and Spanish colonial outpost of Cusco sits perched 11,200 feet in the Andes, affording a vibrant urban gateway to the pastoral Sacred Valley that lies below. Cusco beckons visitors to take in its historic Plaza de Armas and splendid cathedral before heading down to explore the valley, a riverside oasis of villages, ruins and farms flanked by terraced Andean mountainsides.



## Uyuni

Set in Bolivia's southwest corner, the desert outpost of Uyuni affords a welcome oasis among the hauntingly beautiful moonscape that surrounds it. The small town is known for its warm, hospitable locals and easy access to the awe-inspiring vastness of the Salar de Uyuni (Uyuni Salt Flats).



## La Paz

Nestled across a gaping Andean canyon some 13,000 feet above sea level, La Paz boasts the highest elevation of any capital city in the world. This mountain metropolis welcomes guests to wander its winding lanes, stroll its curious market stalls and take in its colonial architecture.



## Lake Titicaca

Lake Titicaca's massive size, eerie stillness and piercing blue hue complement a rich history dating back to the early, pre-Incan hill tribes who still call these shores home. Timeworn cathedrals look out over hand-harvested fields while towering Andean peaks rise over the horizon.

### Machu Picchu Citadel

Overlooking the Urubamba River from its remote Andean perch, this 500-year-old citadel still holds the secret of its passing. Retrace the footsteps of Inca emperors, learning the theories that may one day reveal the truth behind this stunning and mysterious wonder of the world.



### Amazonian Wildlife

The vast Amazon basin boasts an enormous wealth of exotic species. Cruise the river and its tributaries, revealing leopards, caymans, piranhas, parrots, macaws, monkeys, butterflies, egrets, herons and hawks. You may even have the opportunity to swim near elusive pink river dolphins.



### Isla Pescado

Isolated on the windswept barrens of the Uyuni Salt Flats, the oasis of Isla Pescado (Fish Island) rises from the dried-up seabed of this ancient lake. Take in this singularly alien landscape of cacti and rocky outcroppings set against the vast backdrop of the arid salt flats.



### Sun Virgins Temple

Secluded on Lake Titicaca's Moon Island, Iñak Uyu (the Sun Virgins Temple), occupies a dramatic valley evocative of a Roman amphitheater. Explore the adobe ruins of the Incan convent and temple, learning about the lives and fates of the chosen Sun Virgins who called this island home.





## Bogotá

Perched 8,700 feet above sea level, the Colombian capital of Bogotá sprawls across a vast plateau surrounded by the eastern range of the Andes Mountains. Bogotá was founded in 1538 by Spanish conquistador Gonzalo Jiménez de Quesada, eventually growing to boast a population of eight million. This rapidly emerging destination welcomes guests with its historic colonial architecture, thriving nightlife and superb al fresco dining scene. Bogotá also affords a convenient gateway to Colombia's diverse wealth of attractions that lie farther afield.

## Coffee Triangle (Pereira)

Surrounded by the towering Andes, the World-Heritage-Listed Coffee Triangle's rich, volcanic soils and moderate climate make it Colombia's best-known coffee production region. Combining lush green valleys, exotic wildlife and a balmy climate, it is one of Colombia's most sought-after destinations — the perfect place to unwind and relax, while you sit back and sip the fresh, local coffee.

## Cartagena

Cartagena's period architecture; horse-drawn carriages; and narrow, cobbled streets exude colonial charm. This Caribbean jewel was the first Spanish colony on the South American mainland and one of the main ports of the Spanish fleet, shaping it into a powerhouse trade center in the 16th century. Today, the city draws artists, writers, musicians and travellers searching for a muse.



## The Galápagos

Located 600 miles off the coast of Ecuador, this pristine island paradise captivated Charles Darwin in 1835, inspiring his theory of evolution by natural selection. Thankfully, not much has changed on the islands since then. They remain home to an incredible diversity of flora and fauna found nowhere else on the planet, including the blue-footed booby and Galápagos penguin. The island's volcanic landscapes and coral seascapes beckon guests to hike among dozing iguanas and snorkel with frolicking sea lions.



## Quito

Situated in an Andean valley at 9,300 feet, Quito is known for its eternally spring-like climate, storied history and the beauty of its well-preserved colonial city center. Originally settled by the Quito tribe in the first millennium, the area was later partitioned by the Inca Empire, the Spanish conquistadors, the Republic of Greater Colombia and, finally, the Republic of Ecuador.

## Guayaquil

The bustling port of Guayaquil fronts the Pacific Ocean and the Guayas River, serving as a popular gateway to the wilds of the Galápagos. This former Spanish colonial outpost boasts a rich history as an international trading hub. Guayaquil has grown to become Ecuador's largest city, complementing its colorful history with vibrant markets and a revitalized riverfront promenade.

### Bogotá's Colonial Quarter

Capturing the aura of a bygone era, Bogotá's colonial quarter of La Candelaria dazzles with brightly painted stucco and meandering tile rooftops. Travel back in time as you stroll the Plaza de Bolívar's Congress Palace, Cardinal's Palace and the church of El Sagrario.



### Cartagena's Convento de La Popa

Perched atop Cartagena's highest point, the striking Convento de La Popa looks down on the city rooftops some 500 feet below. Take in sweeping views of the bay and cityscape as you learn about the lives of the women who cloistered in this lofty 17th-century enclave.



### Quito's Church of St. Francis

Fronting its namesake Plaza de San Francisco, this imposing 16th-century structure conceals a gilded sanctuary of staggering proportions behind its stark façade. Marvel at the glittering intricacies of its statuary and the grandeur of its soaring ceilings.



### Wildlife of the Galápagos

A protected ecosystem all its own, the Galápagos Islands afford a safe haven for some of the world's most varied wildlife. You may see sunbathing sea lions; skittering Sally Lightfoot crabs; dozing marine iguanas; penguins, finches, terns and blue-footed boobies; or even a century-old tortoise.

### Buenos Aires

As complex as it is energetic and seductive, this port city along the Rio de la Plata has served as Argentina’s gateway for centuries. Buenos Aires represents a microcosm of the country itself, evoking a distinct atmosphere in each of its splendidly diverse *barrios*.

### Ushuaia
