



Examples of AKP-supported projects include:


- Children of the Rainbow, which provides education and housing for underprivileged children in Peru


DAY 3: BARCELONA | FEAST FOR THE SENSES

DAY 5: JEREZ | EQUESTRIAN ARTS

Depart for the coast today. In Jerez, attend a performance at the world-renowned Royal Andalusian School of Equestrian Art and see amazing feats of horsemanship, exquisitely timed and flawlessly executed. Sit down to a late tapas lunch, where parents also enjoy an introduction to the world of sherry. Continue to the port city of Cádiz and your oceanfront Spanish parador.

DAY 6: GIBRALTAR | EXPLORE YOUR WAY

Today offers a tantalizing choice of excursions. DAY 8: MADRID | ARTISTIC TREASURE HUNT



DAYS 4-5: FLORENCE | RENAISSANCE MASTERPIECE

Travel to the sprawling landscapes of Tuscany and stop in medieval Siena. Here, your local expert introduces you to the popular Piazza del Campo, home of the exciting Palio di Siena horse race. Return to the Renaissance gem of Florence. DAY 7: BOLOGNA | BREADBASKET OF ITALY

All such persons and entities are independent contractors. As a result, A&K is not liable for any negligent or willful act of any such person or entity or of any third person. Any party or their representative may appear for the arbitration by telephone or video conference. Each party shall bear its own fees, costs and expenses and an equal share of any arbitrator and administrative fees.






