



## SANCTUARY CHIEF'S CAMP

Okavango Delta, Botswana

Renowned for its outstanding game viewing and exceptional service, Sanctuary Chief's Camp is located on Chief's Island in the Okavango Delta's Moremi Game Reserve. Situated in the "predator capital of Africa," the camp's 10 new secluded bush pavilions feature a private deck and plunge pool. En suite bathrooms include floor-to-ceiling windows, a spacious outdoor shower and an indulgently large bathtub. For those seeking the utmost in privacy, The Geoffrey Kent Suite can accommodate up to six guests, offering two pavilions, a private kitchen, indoor lounge, private *boma* with fire pit, secluded deck area, a private vehicle and guide, a personal waiter, and a private housekeeper. The main lodge offers a dining and bar area, library, pool and spa. Activities include game drives, *mokoro* (local canoe) excursions and, at an additional cost, helicopter flights. *Condé Nast Traveler* routinely rates Sanctuary Chief's Camp as one of Africa's top safari destinations.



## SANCTUARY CHOBE CHILWERO

Chobe National Park, Botswana

Sanctuary Chobe Chilwero is a luxurious riverside retreat in the heart of the bush on the edge of Chobe National Park, home to the world's largest remaining population of elephants. Sitting above the Chobe River, the lodge offers unparalleled panoramic views across the islands and floodplains as far across as Namibia. This is a luxurious lodge with just 15 guest cottages, including a honeymoon suite with a private plunge pool. Chobe Chilwero has the only full spa on the Botswana safari circuit. Relax in the split-level swimming pool, unwind with a pampering session in the spa or enjoy the gourmet food that the lodge has become known for. Activities include game drives and river cruises. Fishing excursions and tours of Victoria Falls are also available at an additional cost.



## SANCTUARY STANLEY'S CAMP

Okavango Delta, Botswana

A classic tented camp located on a private concession overlooking the Okavango floodplains, Sanctuary Stanley's Camp offers a varied game viewing experience as well as a unique elephant interaction. The intimate camp's eight classic, raised platform safari tents exude colonial charm. Each tent features en suite facilities and a private balcony for watching giraffes and gazelle pass by. Set among ebony and sausage trees, the camp is located on a vast private concession bordering the Moremi Game Reserve, with its seasonally changing landscape. Activities include games drives, walking safaris and canoe excursions. The camp's immersive elephant experience and helicopter flights can also be arranged at an additional cost.



## SANCTUARY BAINES' CAMP

Okavango Delta, Botswana

Tucked into the canopy of a private concession bordering the Moremi Game Reserve, Sanctuary Baines' Camp is built on platforms high above the Boro River. This eco-conscious camp offers five opulent suites connected to the pool and deck by suspended walkways. En suite facilities include a bathroom and a private deck where guests can choose to sleep under the open sky or soak in the moonlight with a private star bath. Activities include game drives, walking safaris, and motorboat or canoe excursions. The camp also offers an immersive elephant experience and helicopter flights at an additional cost.



### **SANCTUARY SUSSI & CHUMA** Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park, Zambia

Sanctuary Sussi & Chuma is built on a dramatic bend of the Zambezi River in Mosi-Oa-Tunya National Park, about seven miles upstream from thundering Victoria Falls. Named after Dr. David Livingstone's faithful friends Sussi and Chuma, the lodge is located in one of the most beautiful parts of the Zambezi amid Jackalberry trees and Phoenix palms, providing unrivalled views and exclusivity. Accommodations span 12 Sussi tree houses, which are connected by wooden walkways. There are also two private Chuma houses ideal for families, each one offering two bedrooms, a private chef and guide, as well as their own dining areas, decks, plunge pool and dedicated staff. Sanctuary Sussi & Chuma has an established philanthropy project at Nakatindi Village and School, situated in Livingstone. In 2010, with the help of the community elders, the lodge identified various projects it could assist with on an ongoing basis.



### **SANCTUARY CHICHELE PRESIDENTIAL LODGE** South Luangwa National Park, Zambia

In a prime hilltop location in South Luangwa National Park with views across the river valley and game-filled plains, this gracious, colonial lodge ensures a comfortable and memorable stay. Surrounded by mopane woodlands and grassland savanna, this beautiful property boasts 10 air-conditioned guest rooms with en suite facilities, including a Victorian bath. Enjoy day and night game drives in open safari vehicles and walking safaris to view animals.



### **SANCTUARY PUKU RIDGE CAMP** South Luangwa National Park, Zambia

Nestled on a rocky hillside in the southern area of the game-rich South Luangwa National Park, Sanctuary Puku Ridge Camp is named after the antelopes that graze along the floodplain in front of the camp. The stylish main lodge boasts a spacious lounge, dining area, outdoor deck, spa, air-conditioned gym and infinity swimming pool. Luxurious accommodations, exceptional cuisine, welcoming service and thrilling game viewing combines to create an unforgettable luxury safari experience. The lodge caters for just 16 guests, ensuring personal attention and exclusivity.

Lijiang, China





**AMANYANGYUN**
