

ESSENTIAL INFORMATION WINGS OVER SPAIN & MOROCCO

PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

Your passport needs to be valid for **at least six (6) months** after your journey ends, and should have a minimum of two (2) blank visa pages for entry and exit stamps.

Holders of U.S. and Canadian passports are not required to obtain a tourist visa for entry into either **Spain** or **Morocco** for stays of up to 90 days. On arrival in Morocco, you will be given an "Entry Number." Please keep this number easily accessible as you will be asked to provide it at every hotel on your itinerary.

Citizens of other countries should contact the appropriate consular office for entry requirements pertaining to their journey.

COVID-19 COUNTRY ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & TRAVEL ADVISORIES

A&K requires proof of full COVID-19 vaccination for travel on this journey.

Spain and Morocco currently have no COVID-19 vaccination or testing requirements for entry for U.S. and Canadian residents. Visit the U.S. Department of State at travel.state.gov or the Government of Canada at travel.gc.ca/travelling/advisories for up-to-date information.

LOCAL HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Spain

In accordance with local regulations, face masks must be worn (by all persons aged 6 and over) in pharmacies and while aboard public transportation.

Morocco

Wearing a face mask is not required but recommended.

We encourage you to bring your own masks; a supply will be on hand where needed. Note all protocols are subject to change in accordance with relevant guidelines, local regulations and conditions.

CASH & CREDIT CARDS

In both Spain and Morocco: Cash transactions should be made in local currency. Major credit cards are widely accepted for goods and services at hotels, restaurants and larger shops, however be prepared to pay cash at *souks* and smaller shops. Access to ATM machines is widespread in cities and towns, but may be limited in rural areas.

OF SPECIAL NOTE: SMOKING IN MOROCCO

Smoking is very commonplace in Morocco and you should be prepared to encounter smoking, even in public places that would be deemed smoke-free in the U.S. such as restaurants, shops, museums etc. This also extends into hotels, including hotel rooms categorized as "non-smoking".

While every effort will be made to secure non-smoking rooms when requested, there is no guarantee that smoking did not take place in that room when occupied by previous guests.

PACKING LIST & BAGGAGE RESTRICTIONS

On charter air flights during this journey, each guest is permitted one piece of checked baggage with a maximum weight of approximately 70 pounds (32 kilograms). For carry-on baggage, guests are allowed one piece of baggage with a maximum weight of approximately 10 pounds (4.5 kilograms.) Carry-on bag dimensions must not exceed 7 inches (18 centimeters) x 15 inches (38 centimeters) x 21 inches (53 centimeters).

Please Note: for your time in the A&K Exclusive Desert Tented Camp in Morocco, your luggage is limited to one small bag (tote bag, overnight bag, backpack or similar). We suggest that you repack the evening before you depart Fez and take just those items you will need for your one night in camp. The remainder of your luggage will be held in the care of Abercrombie & Kent and will be returned to you in Marrakech.

Please use the provided A&K luggage tags, even if your bags already have ID tags. This makes it easier for A&K staff to collect and manage your luggage for you.

Safe Travel Essentials

Be sure to bring personal protective equipment (PPE), including face masks, travel-sized hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol, facial tissues and disinfecting wipes or spray.

Clothing

Choose versatile, casual clothing that can be layered if the weather (or level of air-conditioning) requires. Smart casual attire is appropriate for evenings. Formal clothing is not necessary.

Temples, mosques and other religious sites require conservative dress. Both sexes should cover their arms, legs and shoulders (women should pack a scarf for this purpose.) Wear or carry a pair of socks when sightseeing, since shoes must be removed when visiting certain religious sites.

While decisions regarding tipping rest entirely with you, we suggest the following gratuities (noted in U.S. dollars) depending on the type of journey.

For extra nights or Tailor Made services added to a Small Group Journey, please follow the Tailor Made Journeys guidelines for these days only.

Please Note: In Morocco it is extremely common to encounter restroom attendants in airports, bazaars, and other sites frequented by tourists. While not compulsory, it is customary to tip these individuals an amount equal to approximately .25 to .50 cents.
