

ESSENTIAL INFORMATION NETHERLANDS, BELGIUM, GERMANY & LUXEMBOURG

PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

Your passport needs to be valid for **at least six (6) months** after your journey ends, and should have a minimum of four (4) blank visa pages for entry and exit stamps.

Holders of U.S. and Canadian passports are not required to obtain a tourist visa for entry into the Netherlands, Belgium, Germany or Luxembourg for stays of up to 90 days.

Dutch law requires that everyone over the age of 14 carry some form of official identification at all times. A U.S. passport suffices for these purposes.

Citizens of other countries should contact the appropriate consular office for entry requirements pertaining to their journey.

COVID-19 COUNTRY ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & TRAVEL ADVISORIES

The following are the current COVID-19 screening requirements for entry into the Netherlands, Belgium, Germany and Luxembourg for U.S. and Canadian residents. Netherlands, Belgium & Germany

The Netherlands, Belgium and Germany currently have no COVID-19 vaccination or testing requirements for entry for U.S. and Canadian residents.

Luxembourg

- All travellers (aged 12 and over) entering Luxembourg must present an original COVID-19 vaccination certificate indicating full vaccination completed at least 14 days, but no more than nine months prior to arrival. The current approved vaccines are Pfizer (Comirnaty), Moderna (Spikevax), AstraZeneca (Vaxzevria) and Janssen/Johnson & Johnson (Ad26.COV2.S).

Note: Booster shots are required for any traveller who completed full vaccination more than nine months prior to arrival in Luxembourg.

LOCAL HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Netherlands and Belgium

While there are currently no generalized face mask requirements for public spaces in the Netherlands or Belgium, masking regulations may apply in select settings, such as health care facilities.

Germany

Face masks must be worn by everyone over the age of 12 while aboard public transportation. These must be medical-type masks (surgical masks, KN95 or FFP2).

Luxembourg

Face masks are required on all public transportation.

We encourage you to bring your own masks; a supply will be on hand where needed. Note all protocols are subject to change in accordance with relevant guidelines, local regulations and conditions.

CASH & CREDIT CARDS

Major credit cards are widely accepted in these countries, and there is easy access to ATM's.

Banks and exchange facilities may refuse U.S. dollar denominations of \$50 and \$100 if they are not equipped with devices to identify counterfeit currency. Unattended self-service payment kiosks such as those in parking garages, train stations or gas stations only accept a Chip and PIN card or cash.

PACKING LIST

Please use the provided A&K luggage tags, even if your bags already have ID tags. This makes it easier for A&K staff to find and manage your luggage for you.

Safe Travel Essentials

Be sure to bring personal protective equipment (PPE), including face masks, travel-sized hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol, facial tissues and disinfecting wipes or spray.

Clothing

Choose versatile, casual clothing that can be layered if the weather (or level of air-conditioning) requires. Cotton and other light fabrics are comfortable choices for summertime. Pack a coat, hat, gloves, boots, warm socks and sleepwear, if you are visiting these countries between late October and early April. Smart casual attire is appropriate for evenings. Formal clothing is not necessary.

Cathedrals, churches, and other religious sites require conservative dress. Arms and shoulders should be covered.
