

ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

SPAIN

PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

Your passport needs to be valid for at least six (6) months after your journey and should have a minimum of two (2) blank visa pages for entry and exit stamps.

Holders of U.S. and Canadian passports are not required to obtain a tourist visa for entry into Spain.

Citizens of other countries should contact the appropriate consular office for entry requirements pertaining to their journey.

Note: If your travel itinerary includes Gibraltar, which is part of the United Kingdom, you may need a visa if you are not a citizen of the United States or Canada. Please consult the nearest British diplomatic or consular office for information regarding entry requirements.

VACCINATIONS

There are no vaccinations required to enter Spain.

CASH & CREDIT CARDS

In Spain major credit cards (Visa and MasterCard) are widely accepted; Diner's Club and American Express much less so. ATM outlets are widely available. Unattended self-service payment kiosks such as those in parking garages, train stations or gas stations only accept a Chip and PIN card or cash.

PACKING LIST & BAGGAGE RESTRICTIONS

SPAIN

Passenger free checked baggage allowance on flights within Spain is one piece weighing no more than 50 pounds (23 kilos). Any additional or overweight pieces will be charged on check-in. Hand luggage is limited to 22 pounds (10 kilos) and no larger than 21 inches (55 centimeters) x 15 inches (40 centimeters) x 8 inches (20 centimeters). Individual suitcases weighing more than 70 pounds (32 kilos) will not be accepted on Vueling.

Please use the provided A&K luggage tags, even if your bags already have ID tags. This makes it easier for A&K staff to find and manage your luggage for you.

PACKING LIST

Choose versatile, casual clothing that can be layered if the weather (or level of air-conditioning) requires. Cotton and other light fabrics are comfortable choices for summertime. You may find it difficult to exchange US\$100 bills in banks and currency exchanges in smaller towns. Unattended self-service payment kiosks such as those in parking garages, train stations or gas stations only accept a Chip and PIN card or cash.
