PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

A passport is required to travel by air between the United States and Canada. Your passport needs to be valid for **at least six (6) months** after your journey ends, and should have a minimum of one (1) blank visa page for entry and exit stamps.

Holders of U.S. passports are not required to obtain a tourist visa for entry into Canada for stays of up to 180 days.

Citizens of other countries should contact the appropriate consular office for entry requirements pertaining to their journey.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS RELATED TO COVID-19

VACCINATIONS

There are no required vaccinations to enter Canada.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS

During your tour you will be exposed to the elements. As A&K programs to Canada operate in the summer, exposure to the sun is the most common concern, but cold days are also possible at any time of year. Make certain to review the **Packing List** suggestions and check the weather before your trip.

The insect population in Canada varies from year to year. In years with small amounts of rain, the insect population is hardly noticeable, whereas it is much larger in years with heavier rainfall. The population also varies from month to month, with the early summer having far more insects than the mid and late summer months. To prepare and protect for potential heavy insect days, remember to pack insect repellent and wear loose fitting clothing with long sleeves, high socks and closed toed shoes.

CASH & CREDIT CARDS

Cash transactions must be made in Canadian currency. Major credit cards are widely accepted for goods and services. Access to ATM machines is widespread in Winnipeg but limited in Churchill.

BAGGAGE RESTRICTIONS

Baggage Weight Restrictions: On charter flights between Winnipeg and Churchill, luggage is limited to two pieces of checked baggage per person, with a maximum, combined total weight of no more than approximately 70 pounds (32 kilograms). Any single piece of checked baggage exceeding approximately 50 pounds (22.5 kilograms) will be charged an excess luggage fee that must be paid at check in. Individual suitcases weighing more than 70 pounds will not be accepted for carriage. Carry-on baggage is limited to two pieces per person, with a maximum, combined total weight of no more than approximately 20 pounds (9 kilograms) Dimensions of carry-on bags are not to exceed 10 inches (25 centimeters) x 16 inches (40 centimeters) x 12 inches (30 centimeters).

Please use the provided A&K luggage tags, even if your bags already have ID tags. This makes it easier for A&K staff to collect and manage your luggage for you.

PACKING LIST

Choose versatile, casual clothing that can be layered if the weather requires. Smart casual attire is appropriate for evenings. Formal clothing is not necessary.

Clothing

- Casual slacks
- Walking shorts
- Polo shirts, casual short-sleeve shirts or blouses
- Long sleeve shirts or blouses
- Waterproof, well broken-in hiking boots
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Lightweight raincoat
- Two-piece rain suit with hood
- Fleece jacket or vest
- Warm hat and gloves
- Sweater or lightweight jacket
- Brimmed hat for sun protection
- Sleepwear (light and warm)
- Personal garments (light and thermal)
- Socks (socks that ride up to at least mid-calf are recommended to protect against insects)
- Swimwear/cover-up

Other Recommended Items

- Sunglasses
- Sun block
- Insect repellent with DEET
- After Bite
- Simple first-aid kit
- Prescriptions and medications (in their original bottles and/or packaging)
- Extra eyeglasses/contact lenses
- Smartphone

Charging cables for electronics

Foldable umbrella

Optional Items

Small LED flashlight

Foldable walking stick

Lightweight binoculars

Small daypack or fanny pack

Note: Life jackets and other safety gear are provided onsite for all activities in Churchill as necessary.

Traveller's Valet: Complimentary laundry service for 8 articles of clothing per person will be provided at the midpoint of your journey. Dry cleaning is not included.
