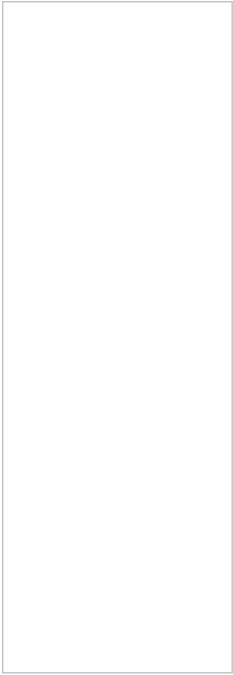

## DAY 1 SUNDAY
