DAY 1 ARRIVE BEIJING, CHINA

DAY 2 BEIJING | TEMPLE OF HEAVEN & TIANANMEN SQUARE

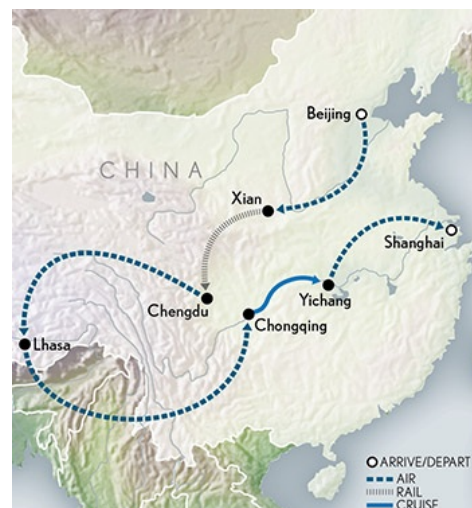
This morning, start the day with a tai chi class at the iconic Temple of Heaven, a stunning example of classical Ming period architecture. Explore historic Tiananmen Square, and then walk in the footsteps of emperors in the Forbidden City, seat of imperial power for centuries.

DAY 3 BEIJING | IMPERIAL BEIJING

Ride a pedicab through a *hutong*, a vast yet intimate neighborhood of small winding alleyways dating to China's dynastic period. Then, travel to the well-preserved Mutianyu section of the Great Wall of China. Walk or ride a cable car to the top of the wall to take in sweeping views of the surrounding mountains.

DAY 4 XIAN | THE ETERNAL CITY

Fly to Xian. Once a vital stop on the Great Silk Road, Xian is a melting pot of Asian and Middle Eastern influences. After lunch, see the Great Mosque during a visit to the Muslim Quarter.

DAY 5 XIAN | THE TERRA COTTA ARMY

Later, enter the Ancient Gate of Xian's City Wall and stroll along its ramparts.

DAY 6 CHENGDU | PEOPLE'S PARK

Later, enjoy a tea demonstration at your hotel.

Disembark to board local "pea pod" boats poled by skilled Tujia boatmen, members of a local minority culture famed for their boat-building skills and keen knowledge of the Yangtze. Later, sail the Xiling Gorge and enjoy a "Taste of China" dinner.

DAY 14 YICHANG TO SHANGHAI | DISEMBARK 'YANGZI EXPLORER'

This morning, disembark and stop over near the Three Gorges Dam. Following time for a photo opportunity, fly to Shanghai. Upon arrival, transfer to your elegant hotel, located on the city's historic Bund. The balance of the afternoon and evening are at leisure.
