ESSENTIAL INFORMATION AZERBAIJAN

PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

Your passport needs to be valid for at least six (6) months after your journey ends, and should have a minimum of one (1) blank visa page for entry and exit stamps.

An electronic visa (eVisa) is required for U.S. and Canadian passport holders for entry into Azerbaijan and must be obtained prior to departure. To apply for an eVisa, visit https://evisa.gov.az/en/. The current fee for a single-entry visa is \$20, plus a \$5 service charge (subject to change without notice.) Read and follow all instructions carefully to ensure a smooth arrival in Azerbaijan. Please be aware that eVisas are valid for 90 days after issuance. Therefore do not apply for your eVisa too far in advance.

Make certain to check the validity of your visa when it is returned to you. Visas cannot be extended once in Azerbaijan. A valid visa is required to depart Azerbaijan or you will be denied permission to leave the country until you pay a substantial fine and secure an exit permit from the State Migration Service in Baku. It is not possible to pay the fine at the airport or any other border crossing.

Please note that U.S. citizens of Armenian ancestry (or with Armenian last names) have had their visa applications denied by the Government of Azerbaijan. Additionally, travelling to the region of Nagorno-Karabakh and the surrounding occupied areas via Armenia without the consent of Azerbaijani authorities could make you ineligible for future travel in Azerbaijan.

CASH & CREDIT CARDS

Azerbaijan has a primarily cash-based economy. Major credit cards are generally only accepted at some hotels and restaurants. Access to ATMs is fairly widespread, however please be cautioned that card skimming at ATMs is an ongoing concern.
